HIGHER HONOURS TITLE - DIAMOND DOUBLE GRAND CHAMPION

Many desexed/Neuters are shown much longer than breeding (Entire) cats so it has been agreed that a further title of "Diamond Double Grand Champion" would be included from 1/1/2024. A further 30 Challenge Certificates would be required to achieve this title, all must be FASA Challenges. We hope this might give exhibitors something further to aim for after reaching "Opal Double Grand Champion" titles and to continue showing their highly titled cats.

CCCA TITLE APPLICATIONS

All applications for CCCA Titles must be submitted to the FASA Secretary with the application form filled in chronological order of shows, **copies of the cat's pedigree** and a copy of the **FASA highest honours certificate awarded** (note this is a new requirement in order for CCCA to process the applications in a timely manner).

NEW SHOW RULE - PROTESTS/DISPUTES AT SHOWS

Please note that if any protests/disputes arise at shows they should immediately be directed to the Show Manager/s. It is often easier to address these matters at the time rather than wait until a meeting by which time memories have faded and the issues can escalate far more than necessary. Your cooperation in this would be appreciated. The following new Show Rule will appear in all schedules and catalogues from 1/1/2024 The new rule to be implemented from 1/1/2024 will read:

Attention Exhibitors

"Please report any problems and issues that arise during the show directly to the Show Manager/s
Any complaints will be handled in confidence, under the FASA Code of Conduct.

Complaints will not be considered after conclusion of the Show."

There are various jobs that all can get involved with regardless of strength and agility.

At set up

trestle set up, trestle wrap, paper towel distribution, spray bottles fill and distribute, prize table set up, put out chairs.

Show day

judges' morning teas, sorting challenges into group and cage number, taking prizes to rings, taking judges slips to data table.

At pull down

Remove fold and store trestle wrap, Dismantle and pack trestles, pack and store chairs, sweep the hall

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR MEMBERS

(Reminder to all Members & Exhibitors)

Members of FASA as a condition of membership agree to abide by the Rules and Policies of the organisation.


Members of FASA are expected to act with integrity, to demonstrate good sportsmanship where competition is concerned and to have good knowledge of and abide by high standards of animal welfare.

All registerable cats, and kittens over the age of 4 months, which are the property of an Ordinary Member of the Association resident in South Australia should be registered with the Association.

Members and Club Affiliates shall, at all times, act within the spirit of the objects of the FASA constitution as set out in clause 2. As the Cat Fancy is made up of various organisations with individual goals & objects, conflicts of interest may arise and need to be acknowledged.

Acting within the spirit of the objects of the FASA constitution includes but is not limited to:

- promoting the objects of the Association;
- engaging in a courteous and professional manner with each other and/or with the public;
- not bringing the Association into disrepute or otherwise attract negative publicity whether in person, in writing and/or in particular via use of social media, such as use of "Facebook" (refer Social Media Policy for more detail);
- abiding by the policy of Responsible Cat Ownership.
