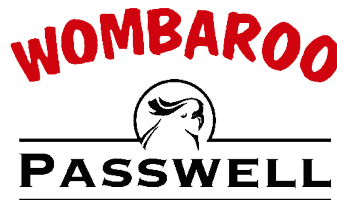
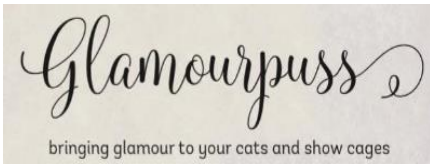

**... Introducing our International Judge ...**

**Neil Quigley (CFA Canada)**



I was born in Saskatoon, Canada – the fourth child in a family of seven. Cats have always been a part of my life. As a small child I convinced my parents to adopt a stray kitten who became part of the family and later with my sister we raised Siamese as teens. I have bred and shown Ocicats for over 20 years under the Tribal cattery name with my dear friend Lynn Boelter. We were fortunate enough to receive many regional wins and 2 national wins including 7<sup>th</sup> best cat in 2004. I have exhibited a number of other shorthair breeds, primarily Siamese, Color point Shorthairs and Japanese Bobtails. Over the years I have become a member of several clubs in the Northwest Region and participated extensively in show productions. I have served as Ocicat breed council secretary for 2 terms and for 5 years I was the exhibitor member of the CFA Judging Program Committee. I was responsible for assisting applicants in assembling their applications to the judging panel and during this time I became interested in becoming a judge myself. I was accepted as a shorthair trainee in 2010 and became an approved all breed judge in 2017. I have judged in the United States, China, Hong Kong, Indonesia, New Zealand and Australia. In my other life I worked for a large petroleum company for many years as a finance analyst and retired in 2017.
